

Cats with Chronic Kidney Disease



NC State College of Veterinary Medicine is recruiting cats with stage 2 or 3 chronic kidney disease for a one-time therapeutic injection.

PARTICIPATION: Owner must be willing to bring their cat to the Veterinary Hospital for 8 study visits over the course of 10 months. They must complete a weekly questionnaire at home (38 weeks) and cats must eat a renal prescription diet throughout the study. This is a placebo-controlled study but placebo cats will have the option of receiving treatment if they have disease progression. Treatment consists of a one-time ultrasound guided injection into each kidney.

STUDY BENEFITS:

This study is fully funded and at no cost to the owner. Study treatment and all related procedures and diagnostics are free.

INCLUSION CRITERIA:

- 7 years of age or greater
- Lives indoors
- Stage 2 or 3 CKD but in otherwise good health
